Subject: **Overview of 2022 buck deer permit recommendations**

The attached tables summarize the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources' recommended permit allocations for the 2022 buck deer hunts. We've made these recommendations after evaluating 2021 harvest information and conducting post-hunt assessments of herd composition.

The number of permits we're proposing for 2022 will help us achieve or maintain the objectives detailed in Utah's mule deer management plan for harvest size, animal quality and hunting opportunity. For specific information about how individual big game species are managed, please refer to <https://wildlife.utah.gov/> and use the search field to find the statewide management plan for the species of interest.

Below is a summary of the **2022 big game permit recommendations**:

- 1) For general-season deer hunting, we manage a total of 29 hunting units. There are 19 units with a post-season objective of 18-20 bucks per 100 does and 10 units with an objective of 15-17 bucks per 100 does. For 2022, we are recommending permit increases on 10 units, no changes on 4 units, and permit decreases on the remaining 13 units. Statewide, we are recommending 73,075 general-season permits, which is a 950-permit decrease compared to last year.
- 2) Utah's premium limited-entry deer units — Henry Mtns and Paunsaugunt — are managed for older bucks (the management objective requires at least 40% of the harvested bucks should be five years or older). For 2022, we recommend no changes in permits on either the Henry Mtns (49 permits, three-year average of bucks five years or older is 64%) or the Paunsaugunt (135 permits, three-year average of bucks five years or older is 68%).



- 3) Premium limited-entry deer units are managed for 40-55 bucks per 100 does post-season. For 2021, we recommend no management buck permits on the Henry Mtns (three-year average is 36 bucks per 100 does) and a no change in management buck permits on the Paunsaugunt with 15 permits (three-year average is 42 bucks per 100 does). We recommend the same number of Paunsaugunt cactus buck permits for 2022, with 30 permits.
- 4) We recommend five permits per unit on the three Handgun, Archery, Muzzleloader, and Shotgun (HAMS) units, for a total of 15 permits.
- 5) We recommend reducing 50 limited-entry deer permits, decreasing from 1,315 permits to 1,265 permits.

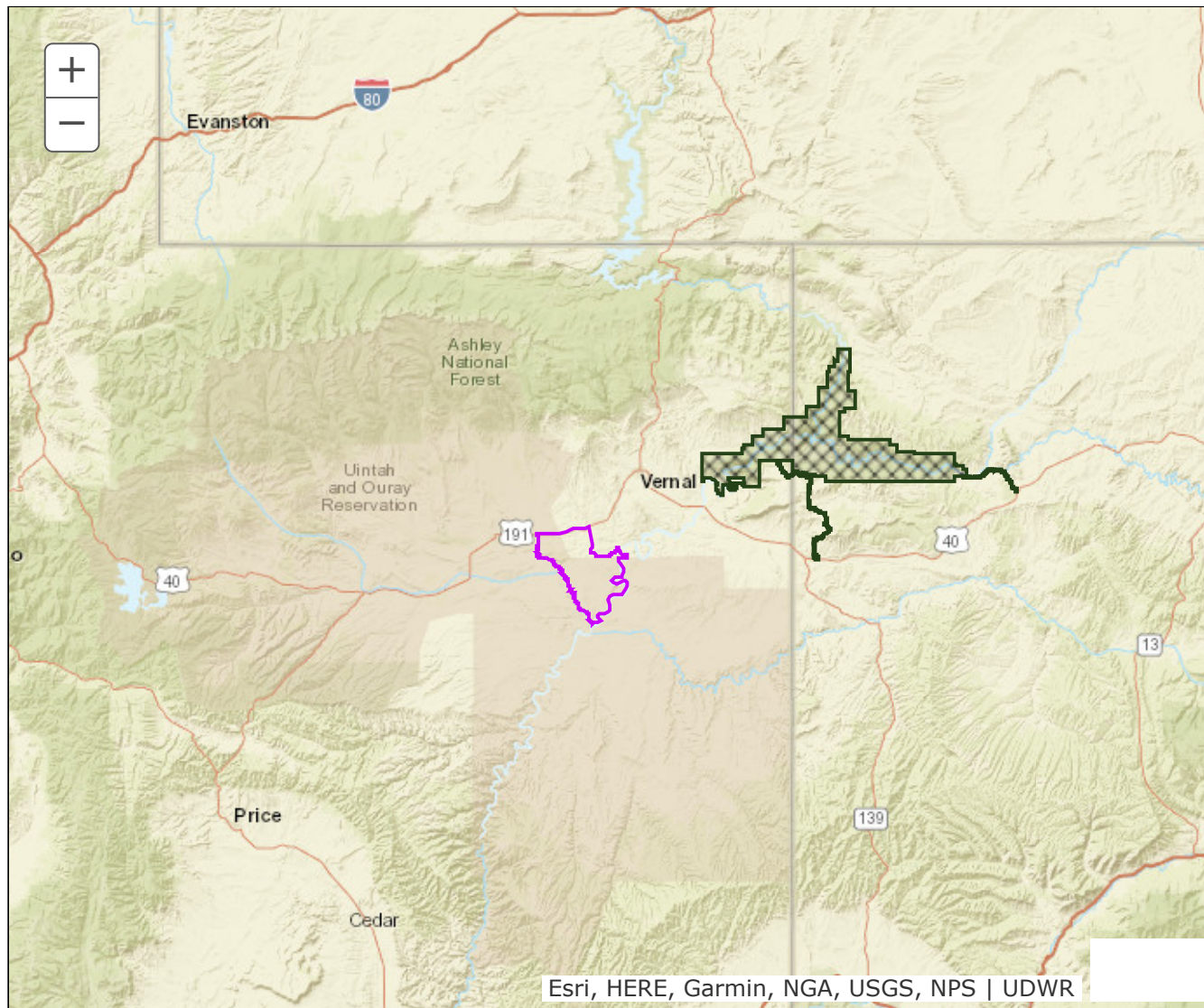

The attached tables summarize the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources' recommended permit allocations for the 2022 bull elk and buck pronghorn hunts. We've made these recommendations after evaluating 2021 harvest information and conducting post-hunt assessments of herd composition.

The number of permits we're proposing for 2022 will help us achieve or maintain the objectives detailed in Utah's big game management plans for harvest size, animal quality and hunting opportunity. For specific information about how individual big game species are managed, please refer to <https://wildlife.utah.gov/> and use the search field to find the statewide management plan for the species of interest.

Below is a summary of the **2022 bull elk and buck pronghorn permit recommendations**:

- 1) We recommend 15,000 spike elk permits and 17,500 any bull permits, as defined in the statewide elk plan.
- 2) We recommend no changes to the number of youth any bull elk permits (500 permits).
- 3) We recommend adding 66 limited-entry bull elk permits, increasing from 2,990 permits to 3,056 permits.
- 4) We recommend adding 76 buck pronghorn permits, increasing from 1,173 permits to 1,249 permits.

Subject: Once in a lifetime permit recommendations

Big game permit recommendations are reviewed annually. Recommendations are traditionally presented during the April RAC and Board.

Number of permits are recommended on the following criteria:

- Bighorn Sheep
 - After a population census flight we recommend permits based on 12-25% of counted rams or 30-60% of rams older than 6 years
- Bison
 - We recommend permit numbers based on the herd population objective
- Mtn. Goat
 - We recommend permit numbers that result in the harvest of 5-25% of the counted adult population
- Moose
 - We recommend permit numbers that result in an average age of bull harvest between 3.75-4.25 years

Permit recommendations are made in an effort to stay within the parameters of the plan.

Subject: **Overview of 2022 big game and antlerless permit recommendations**

The attached tables summarize the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources' recommended permit allocations for the 2022 antlerless hunts. We've made these recommendations after evaluating 2021 harvest information and conducting post-hunt assessments of herd composition.

The number of permits we're proposing for 2022 will help us achieve or maintain the objectives detailed in Utah's big game management plans for harvest size, animal quality and hunting opportunity. For specific information about how individual big game species are managed, please refer to <https://wildlife.utah.gov/> and use the search field to find the statewide management plan for the species of interest.

Below is a summary of the **2022 antlerless hunt recommendations**:

- 1) In 2021, the statewide deer population decreased (by approximately 7,200 animals) to a total of 305,700 deer. This decrease was primarily due to drought conditions in spring, summer, and fall of 2020 in combination with drought spring and summer of 2021. Populations in portions of the southern parts of the state showed the loss while some populations in northern Utah showed growth.
- 2) For 2022, we recommend reducing 300 antlerless deer permits — decreasing from 935 permits to 635 permits — and adding one new hunt in Vernal-Ouray Valley. Antlerless deer hunts are designed to reduce depredation on private lands, tackle urban deer issues, address CWD hotspots, and help slow the decline of range conditions.
- 3) Statewide, elk populations increased slightly in 2021. Antlerless permits are needed to keep elk populations within their management objectives. The statewide elk population objective is 78,990 elk, and the current statewide estimate is 84,390 elk. We recommend 7,948 antlerless elk permits for the public drawing in 2022, as compared to 8,285 permits in 2021 — an decrease of 337 permits.



- 4) For the 2022 public drawing, we recommend adding 5 antlerless elk hunts. We recommend antlerless elk-control permits on the following seven units:
- Henry Mtns
 - Chalk Creek
 - Morgan-South Rich
 - West Desert, East
 - East Canyon
 - Pine Valley
 - Zion
- 5) We recommend 9,160 private-lands-only permits on 24 units throughout the state to increase harvest and hunting pressure on private lands. We recommend season dates from Aug. 1, 2022–Jan. 31, 2023. Hunters may use any legal weapon during these hunts. Private-lands-only hunts have minimized depredation challenges in many parts of the state. Hunt units include:

- 6) We recommend eliminating 126 doe pronghorn permits, decreasing from 404 permits to 278 permits. We also recommend adding a new hunt on the Nine Mile, Anthro-Pleasant Valley unit.
- 7) We recommend 18 antlerless moose permits.
- 8) We recommend continuing the Rocky Mountain ewe bighorn sheep hunt on the Box Elder, Newfoundland Mtns unit, with a total of 5 permits.

Subject: **2022 Cooperative Wildlife Management Unit (CWMU) permit recommendations**

 - 11 renewal applications

- There will be a total of 69 CWMUs with antlerless permits for the 2022 hunting season, based on the DWR’s recommendations. The following table summarizes the recommended number of antlerless CWMU permits statewide:
