


BOUNDARY RECOMMENDATION

UNIT South Slope, Buckskin Hills-Jensen

SPECIES Elk



Updated Boundary: Uintah County—Boundary begins at the USFS southern boundary and the Uinta River; southeast along this river to the Duchesne River; south along the Duchesne River including a 1 mile buffer on the west side of the Duchesne river to the Green River near Ouray; northeast along the Green River including a 1 mile buffer on the east side of the Green River to Hwy 40; east on Hwy 40 to the Utah/Colorado border; north along the border to Harpers Corner Road; north and west along Harpers Corner Road to the Dinosaur National Monument boundary; south and west along this boundary to where Hwy 149 crosses the Green River; west along the Green River to Hwy 149 again and the Dinosaur National Monument boundary; north and east on Dinosaur National Monument boundary to the Island Park road; west on this road to the Brush Creek road; north on this road to the Diamond Mountain road; north on this road to the Diamond Mountain rim; west along this rim to the USFS boundary; west on this boundary to the Uinta River. This hunt is comprised of all or largely private property. Hunters should acquire written permission from the landowner before applying for this hunt. EXCLUDES ALL NATIVE AMERICAN TRUST LANDS WITHIN THIS
