SUBJECT: Amendment to Drawing application (R657-62) – Deployed Military

To show appreciation for our service members, the Division recommends waiving the combination/hunting license requirement for all resident deployed military members if the missed the opportunity to acquire a bonus or preference points.

The Division also recommends allowing all resident deployed military members the opportunity to acquire a bonus or preference point if they missed the application period while serving our country.

To qualify they must:

- Be deployed for 90 consecutive days or more during the calendar year of the application.
- Not have previously received a bonus or preference point for the species and hunt type in the same year.
- Otherwise be eligible to receive a bonus or preference point.
- Pay a \$10 application fee per point.
- Submit an application to the Division no later than December 31st of the calendar year of qualifying deployment.

Deployed means movement from a military's personnel permanent duty station to active duty outside the continental U.S. and its territories on federal orders from military command.
