To whom it may concern:

As of 2002 under Utah Code Section 23-19-38.2 enacted by the Legislature, we are now able to process a refund for an Armed Forces member. Please fill out the attached form and provide documentation in order to qualify for a refund.

TO QUALIFY, THE PERSON OR LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE MUST:

- notify the division within a reasonable amount of time that the person is applying for a refund; **and**
- surrender the license, certificate, tag, or permit to the division; **and**
- furnish satisfactory proof to the division that the person is a member of:
 - the United States Armed Forces; or
 - a public health organization; or
 - a public safety organization; **and**
- verify that the deployment or mobilization completely precluded the person from participating in the activity authorized by the wildlife document.

APPLICATION FOR A REFUND FOR A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, PUBLIC HEALTH, OR PUBLIC SAFETY

Rule R657-42-5 provides:

A person may receive a refund for a wildlife document if that person was deployed or mobilized on or after September 11, 2001, in the interest of national defense or national emergency and is thereby completely precluded from participating in the hunting or fishing activity authorized by the wildlife document provided:

- the refund request is made to the division within one year of the end of hunting or fishing season authorized by the wildlife document; **and**
- the person surrenders the wildlife document to the division, or signs an affidavit stating the wildlife document is no longer in the person's possession; **and**
- the person verifies that the deployment or mobilization completely precluded them from participating in the activity authorized by the wildlife document.
