Dear Brine Shrimp Harvester:

The 2021-2022 brine shrimp harvest season will officially be closed on January 27, 2022 at 5:39 pm MST (official sunset) in both the North and South Arms (lake and shore) pursuant to Rule R657-52-12. Harvest may continue on the salt ponds but must still be reported to the UDWR in the same manner as during the regular season.

A sampling run on the south arm of Great Salt Lake was conducted on January 24, 2022. The enumeration and analysis have been completed. All presented values are per liter of lake water.
