

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES
TO THE 2010-2011 UTAH COUGAR GUIDEBOOK
ESTABLISHED BY THE WILDLIFE BOARD
FOR TAKING COUGAR**

I, James F. Karpowitz, by authority granted in Utah Code Section 23-14-8, declare an emergency amendment to the 2010-2011 Utah Cougar Guidebook. The following has been amended:

BOOK CLIFFS, RATTLESNAKE CANYON (Grand County)

- Effective March 4, 2011 the cougar harvest quota on the Book Cliffs, Rattlesnake Canyon unit (unit 10b) will be increased from 2 to 4.

SAN RAFAEL (Carbon, Emery, Wayne Counties)


- Effective March 4, 2011 the cougar harvest quota on the San Rafael unit (unit 12) will be increased from 3 to 5.

WASATCH MOUNTAINS, CASCADE (Utah, Wasatch Counties)

- Effective March 4, 2011 the cougar harvest quota on the Wasatch Mountains, Cascade unit (unit 17a2) will be increased from 10 to 14.

The purpose of these emergency changes is to protect declining bighorn sheep herds from additive cougar predation and/or to protect bighorn sheep herds that are the primary prey animal available to cougar. These units are under Predator Management Plans to protect bighorn sheep from cougar predation. These specific units were selected because the cougar harvest quota has been met, which closes the units to additional cougar harvest for the remainder of the 2010-11 season.

Except for other emergency changes made since January 1, 2011 all other rules established in the 2010-2011 Cougar Guidebook remain in effect.
