

Muskrat Trapping Bid In-Kind Values 2015

Labor for fence repair \$2/rod labor only (not a major repair/rebuild)

-UDWR provides materials

Fence construction: \$40/rod labor and materials

Wood post set one rod apart, buried 30 inches deep with 4 strand barbless wire stapled and one dancer between each post. Brace all corners and at every opening with a standard corner brace ("H" and "slant brace" three post) and every ¼ mile with 'H' brace.

Electric Fence installation and removal: \$8/rod

We provide materials or they provide receipts for credit.

Double strand electric installation and removal with step in fiberglass/plastic posts every 33 feet (two rods) and one steel "T" post every 198 feet or (12 rods or every sixth post). All corners are to be wood or steel posts with insulators and tension springs. Gates openings are to wood posts and have swinging/opening non-electrified gates with latches for securing.

Mowing of grass and weeds: \$25/acres

Cut and leave scattered on the ground with sickle bar or rotary type mowers to be determined by Manager @ \$ 25/acre

Disking once: \$18/acre

Applicant provides equipment, operator, fuel and are responsible for operating and maintenance costs of equipment.

Planting food plots: \$22/acre

Applicant provides equipment, operator, fuel and are responsible for operating and maintenance costs of equipment. Preparation of ground and planting with DWR seed \$40/acre.

Backhoe excavation: \$85/hr

Applicant provides equipment, operator, fuel and are responsible for operating and maintenance costs of equipment. Primary task will be ditch cleaning.

Cat 320 Track or similar hoe excavation: \$125/hr

Applicant provides equipment, operator, fuel and are responsible for operating and maintenance costs of equipment.

Hanging tube gates: \$20 gate

This will be performed on existing fence, material provided by DWR or receipt will be credited for purchase of gate (per DWR specifications).

Added "H" brace \$25 each:

DWR provide materials.

Purchase of materials: In lieu of payment or in-kind labor. Applicant will be credited with receipts of merchandise purchased that was requested by the Area Manager (*gates, panels, standard fencing materials, electric fence materials, contracted labor, etc.*)
