

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES  
TO THE 2013 UTAH FISHING GUIDEBOOK  
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING  
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH**

I, Gregory Sheehan, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2013 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

**Upper Mill Creek (From Elbow Fork to Headwaters, Salt Lake County):**

- INCREASE the daily bag and possession limit to eight (8) fish

Native Bonneville cutthroat trout (BCT) are being restored into Mill Creek Canyon. Beginning in September 2013, in preparation to reintroduce BCT into Mill Creek, existing fish in the upper portions of the canyon will be removed from Elbow Fork upstream to the headwaters. Limits are being temporarily liberalized to allow anglers to harvest fish that would otherwise be lost.

These changes are effective immediately and will remain in effect until January 1, 2014. All other rules established in the 2013 Utah Fishing Guidebook remain in effect.
