

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES
TO THE UTAH FISHING PROCLAMATION
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH 2018**

I, Mike Fowlks, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2018 Utah Fishing Proclamation. The following has been amended:


EAST FORK BOULDER CREEK, GARKANE UPPER IMPOUNDMENT also known as KINGS PASTURE POND (Garfield County):

The daily bag and possession limit for brook trout has been removed.

East Fork Boulder Creek has been identified as a site for reintroducing Colorado River cutthroat trout. To assist in the removal of nonnative brook trout anglers are encouraged to harvest all brook trout caught.

These changes are effective immediately and will remain in effect until January 1, 2019. All other rules established in the 2018 Utah Fishing Proclamation remain in effect.
