The competition is open to children and teens (**ages 3–18**), and submissions will be accepted from **Feb. 1–28, 2026**.

## HOW TO SUBMIT AN ENTRY

1. Download and print the official coloring page.
2. Submit your completed coloring page in one of two ways:
  - A. **In person:** Bring it to the Eccles Wildlife Education Center any **Tuesday–Saturday, from 11 a.m.–4 p.m.**
  - B. **By mail:** Your entry must be postmarked by **Feb. 28, 2026**.

## DISPLAY OF ENTRIES:

All submissions will be displayed at the Eccles Wildlife Education Center throughout **February**. Winning entries will be showcased in **March**.

**CATEGORIES AND PRIZES:** The contest features four age-based categories:

- Ages 3–5
- Ages 6–9
- Ages 10–13
- Ages 14–18

Each contestant must do their own coloring, without help from adults or older children. Judges may look at creativity, neatness, color choice and effort. Three winners will be selected in each category, and they will receive prizes. Winners will be officially announced on the education center's social media accounts after the Feb. 28 deadline.
