

Limited Entry Landowner Permits – Elk Application - 2026

The Division of Wildlife offers limited-entry permits to private landowners who are not a part of a Landowner Association or CWMU, but have property located within a limited-entry unit. These permits are available for bull elk (also deer/pronghorn – see other application form), are issued through a drawing and are valid for a landowner’s property only.

Eligible Property:

- Must meet a minimum of 640 acres* of habitat for elk
- Must be located in a limited-entry unit for one of those species
- Must not be used in a CWMU or LOA
- Must be in agricultural use as provided in Utah Code Section 59-2-502 and 503 (Greenbelt status).

Any parcel of private land may only be considered once. *If multiple applications for the same parcel are submitted, all applications for that parcel will be rejected.* A landowner may only apply for (1) limited-entry landowner species per year. Eligible landowners may apply for and receive one landowner elk voucher per 640 eligible acres.

*If your property contains non-contiguous lands, you will be required to submit your application in blocks of minimum 640 acres.

Qualifying applications must be received between March 1 and March 31 at the regional office where the qualifying land is located. **We encourage you to submit your application electronically to the appropriate regional email address listed below.** A digital map of the eligible property indicating parcel numbers, county and limited-entry hunt unit must be included with this application. *No late applications will be accepted.*

Once an application is reviewed and approved, landowners will be contacted to pay a \$10 application fee (and 2.2% transaction fee) per voucher applied for which must be collected by June 5 or the application will not be included in the drawing. The drawing will take place by late June. *Bonus points are not used or accrued for this drawing.*

Limited-entry elk landowners are only required to submit a qualifier application once every three years, so long as their property and its acreage have not changed in any way. They will still be required to pay applicable application fees each year to be included in the drawing.

Those successful in the drawing will be issued vouchers to redeem for bull elk permits good for their choice of eligible season/weapon type for their unit. These elk vouchers may be redeemed by anyone and/or sold.
