We will host a meeting for those associated with the brine shrimp harvest on Tuesday September 25th, 2018. The meeting will begin at 10:30 a.m. and should be finished not later than noon. An hour will likely be sufficient to cover the topics. The meeting will be held in the main floor conference rooms (1040 and 1050) at the Department of Natural Resource Building located at 1594 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Aviation representatives will be present to discuss issues and regulations regarding air traffic control and access to a portion of the West Desert Range. Clover Control has done an exemplary job over the years to offer assistance and allow access to the range and we would like to maintain that positive relationship. In recent years, very little has changed in this process. However, there are some new procedures for this upcoming season. I would suggest all pilots that will be flying for the companies attend. Safety is the primary issue and all pilots need to do their part so this mutually cooperative effort can continue.

Other topics to be discussed include brine shrimp population performance and harvest reporting. Law enforcement personnel for both Wildlife Resources and Parks and Recreation will attend and be available to answer questions.
