

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGE
TO THE 2026 UTAH FISHING GUIDEBOOK
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH**

I, Riley Peck, by authority granted in Section 23A-2-203 of the Wildlife Resources Code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2026 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

Nine Mile Reservoir (Sanpete County):


- 16 trout

This change is effective May 11, 2026, and will remain in effect until October 1, 2026.

Nine Mile Reservoir is experiencing drought-related water losses that exceed losses experienced during periods with normal precipitation. The Utah Division of Wildlife Resources (Division) is concerned that fish will not survive the summer and we are therefore proactively liberalizing the limit to 1) reduce trout densities and improve survival of any remaining fish and 2) encourage anglers to make use of fish that would otherwise perish.

All other rules established in the 2026 Utah Fishing Guidebook remain in effect.
