

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES  
TO THE UTAH FISHING GUIDEBOOK  
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING  
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH 2021**

I, Rory Reynolds, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2021 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

**Central Region:**

**Payson Lake (Big East), Utah County**

- Limit 8 trout

**McClellan Reservoir, Utah County**

- Limit 8 trout

**Fairview Lakes, Sanpete County**

- Limit 8 trout

**Towne (Town) Reservoir, Sanpete County**

- Limit 8 trout

**Palisade Reservoir, Sanpete County**

- Limit 20 in aggregate wiper, trout (any species), and black crappie

**Mona Reservoir, Juab County**

- Limit 20 in aggregate wiper largemouth bass, and smallmouth bass

**Northern Region:**

**Newton Reservoir, Cache County**

- Limit 100 bluegill
- Limit 100 yellow perch
- Limit 100 black crappie

**Pineview Reservoir, Weber County**

- Limit 100 bluegill
- Limit 100 yellow perch
- Limit 40 black crappie
- Limit 48 black bullhead

**Southeast Region:**

**Monticello Lake, San Juan County**

- Limit 8 trout

**Southern Region:**

**OTTER CREEK RESERVOIR, Piute County**

- Limit 16 trout
- Limit 12 wiper
- Limit 24 smallmouth bass

These changes are effective immediately and will remain in effect until October 31, 2021. All other rules, established in the 2021 Utah Fishing Guidebook remain in effect.

These regulation changes prompted by on-going drought conditions. The waters identified by these changes are expected to experience low water levels this year and fish loss is expected due to adverse conditions. The intention of these regulation changes are to liberalize harvest and provide anglers the opportunity to harvest additional fish prior to fish loss, if loss occurs.

I, Rory Reynolds, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2021 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

**NAVAJO LAKE**, Sevier County

- Limit 16 trout, any size

These changes are effective immediately and will remain in effect until October 31, 2021. All other rules, established in the 2021 Utah Fishing Guidebook remain in effect.

The Utah Division of Wildlife Resources is considering a rotenone treatment at Navajo Lake to remove an over abundant population of Utah Chub. Trout are currently struggling in the lake due to competition for food and oxygen. This regulation change allows anglers to harvest additional trout ahead of a rotenone treatment that is anticipated fall 2021.
