


## BOUNDARY RECOMMENDATION

**UNIT** La Sal, Moab Valley

SPECIES Deer



**Updated Boundary:** Grand and San Juan counties— Northern boundary is Colorado River between Kane Creek Boulevard and the bridge where Hwy 191 crosses the Colorado River. SE on Hwy 191 to the junction with E 300 S in Moab. E 300 S to S 400 E. S 400 E to the Sand Flats Rd. Sand Flats Rd to junction with La Sal Loop Rd. S on Loop Rd until it junctions with connector road to Hwy 191. N on Hwy 191 to junction with Kane Creek Boulevard. Kane Creek Boulevard to the Colorado River. USGS 1:100,000 Maps: La Sal, Moab. Boundary questions? Call Price office, 435-613-3700. - A hunting permit does not authorize the permit holder to hunt on Native American trust lands, CWMUs (unless you specifically have a permit for that CWMU) or on National Park lands. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of hunters to learn if hunting is allowed and what specific rules and regulations may apply on National Monuments, National Wildlife Refuges, State Parks, UDWR Wildlife and Waterfowl Management areas, military installations and within the boundaries of cities, towns and municipalities. Written permission is required to hunt private lands.
