


BOUNDARY RECOMMENDATION

UNIT Manti, Ferron-Nelson Mtn

SPECIES Elk



Updated Boundary: Emery County — Boundary begins at the Jct. of SR10 and Canyon Road (100 South) in Ferron. South along SR10 to mile post 20; west along the prominent ridgeline to the top of the escarpment then north along the ridgeline to Youngs Peak; north to the head of Jims Fork; west down Jims Fork to USFS road 135 (the Hole Trail); northwest on the Hole Trail to USFS road 315; north along USFS road 315 to USFS road 316; north and northeast along USFS road 316 to the Blue Trail; northeast then north along the Blue Trail to Canyon Road; east along Canyon Road to SR10 in Ferron. USGS 1:100,000 Maps: Manti. Boundary questions? Call Price office, 435-613-3700. - A hunting permit does not authorize the permit holder to hunt on Native American trust lands, CWMUs (unless you specifically have a permit for that CWMU) or on National Park lands. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of hunters to learn if hunting is allowed and what specific rules and regulations may apply on National Monuments, National Wildlife Refuges, State Parks, UDWR Wildlife and Waterfowl Management

areas, military installations and within the boundaries of cities, towns and municipalities. Written permission is required to hunt private lands.
