


## **BOUNDARY RECOMMENDATION**

**UNIT** Wasatch Mtns, Salt Lake-Timpanogos

**SPECIES** Moose



**Updated Boundary:** Salt Lake, Summit, Utah and Wasatch counties—Boundary begins at I-80 and I-15 in Salt Lake City; east on I-80 to US-40; south on US-40 to Hwy 189; south on Hwy 189 to I-15 in Provo; north on I-15 to I-80 in Salt Lake City. Excludes all CWMUs. USGS 1:100,000 Maps: Provo, Salt Lake City. Boundary questions? Call the Springville office, 801-491-5678. - A hunting permit does not authorize the permit holder to hunt on Native American trust lands, CWMUs (unless you specifically have a permit for that CWMU) or on National Park lands. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of hunters to learn if hunting is allowed and what specific rules and regulations may apply on National Monuments, National Wildlife Refuges, State Parks, UDWR Wildlife and Waterfowl Management areas, military installations and within the boundaries of cities, towns and municipalities. Written permission is required to hunt private lands.
